We are all very excited about the Summer Festival and hope that many of you will be able to join us for what promises to be a wonderful community event.

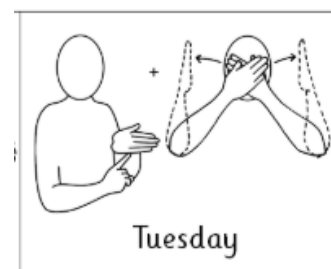

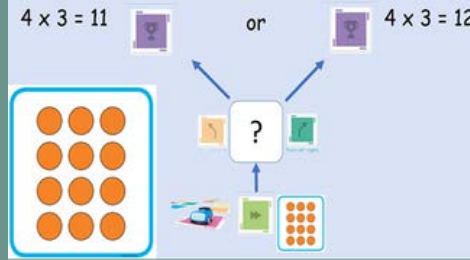
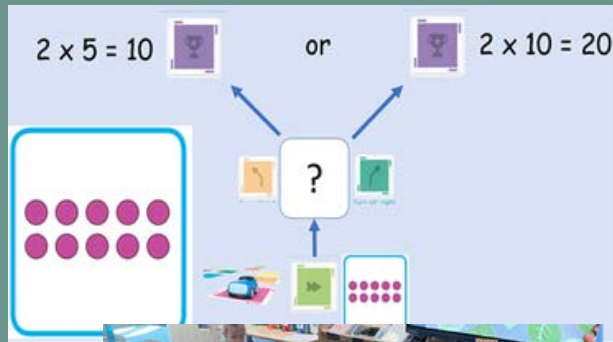
# DIGITAL SPOTLIGHT- EYFS

Reception had a great time taking photos and recording voice notes. The children enjoyed using technology to capture their ideas and share their thoughts

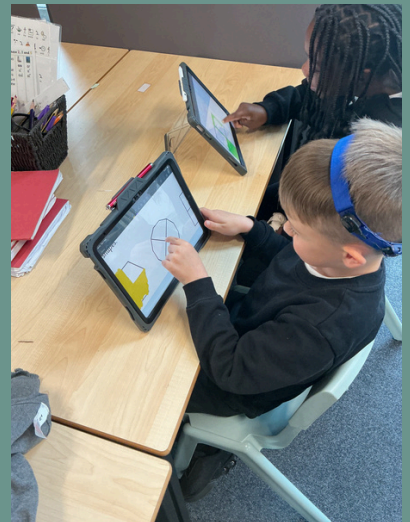
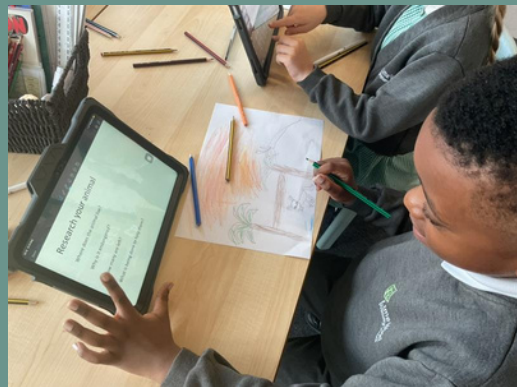


# DIGITAL SPOTLIGHT- KSI
