Respect - The children showed great respect towards our two Jolly Postman visitors this week and loved handing over their letters to Santa to take them to the North Pole on a special delivery!


Curiosity - The children saw some footage that captured the Gingerbread Man running and escaping in their classroom - this sparked much excitement and curiosity!
