Free Family Learning for parents and carers at your school or setting

Family Learning empowers parents to develop skills that can significantly improve outcomes for their children, families, and the wider community. It helps parents build positive parenting strategies, gain a better understanding of their child's needs, and support their development and learning at home.

LECB offers free Family Learning courses exclusively for your school community. We will work closely with you and your parents to decide which courses would be most beneficial, delivered at times that suit your setting.

Courses are flexible in length. While many run for around five weeks, we can also deliver shorter two-hour workshops or longer courses of up to ten weeks, depending on what best meets the needs of your families.

To access these fully funded courses, all participants must complete an enrolment form and provide proof of ID, in line with the funding requirements.

Family Learning has a powerful impact. Engaging parents through learning can help address disadvantage, build confidence, improve life chances, and enable families to better support their children throughout school and life.

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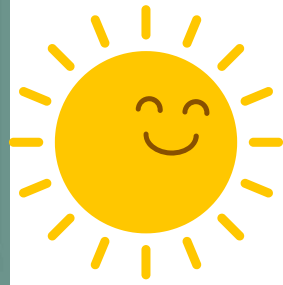
