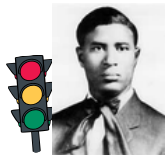

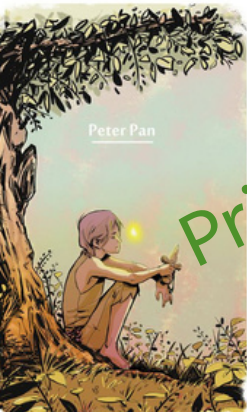

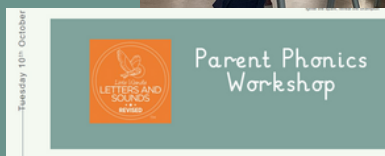

Support our local community by parking with care. Please use the school car park for morning drop off and afternoon collection to support our local residents.



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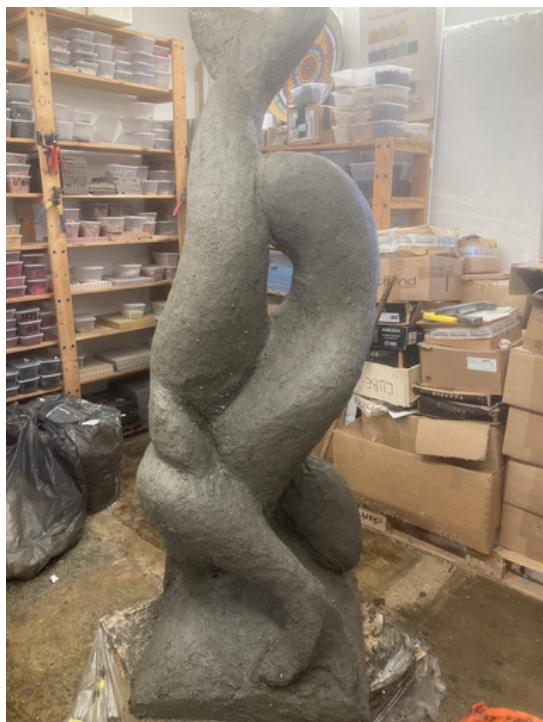
