Science Week 2024 - Our focus for Science Week was linked directly to the EYFS framework and expected level of development:

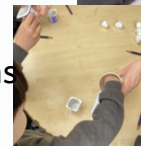
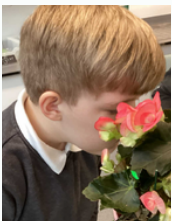
- To explore the natural world around them, making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants

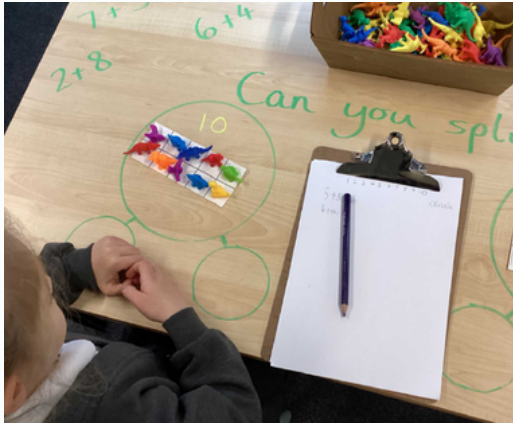

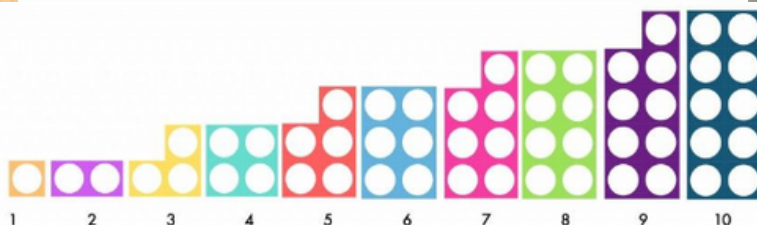
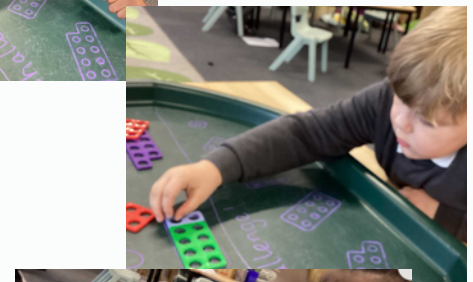
They have used ten frames to help them find two numbers to make ten.


