Wishing you all a restful weekend.

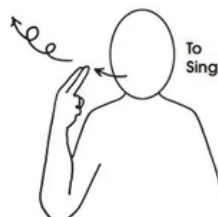

# MENTAL HEALTH WEEK



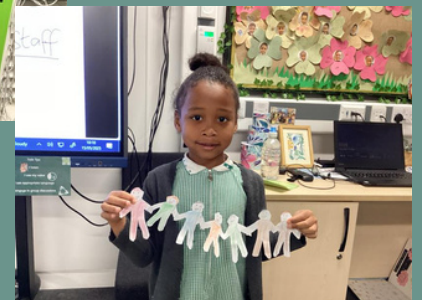
Reception revisited their knowledge of vocabulary linked to emotions and our colour monsters.
