The school deals with bullying effectively

When I have raised concerns they have been dealt with properly














We have been so proud of the children's writing development over the past term. Independent writing is really showing some great progress - we love these letters that children wrote back to Bill!



Phonic knowledge is supported through the use of IPADs too in order to support sentence construction allowing children to independently apply their skills.

Each classroom as well as our outside area has a Phonics station to further support children's development of knowledge and skills. Activities are updated each week in order to provide challenge.



We use an intervention called Colourful Semantics to support children's ability to construct a sentence - they have been making some great sentences!
