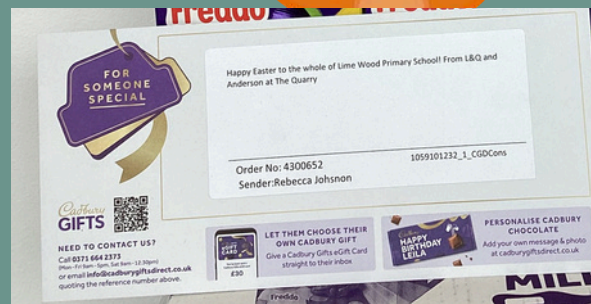
Wishing you all a fun-filled and restful half-term break. We look forward to welcoming everyone back on 20th April for the final term of the academic year.

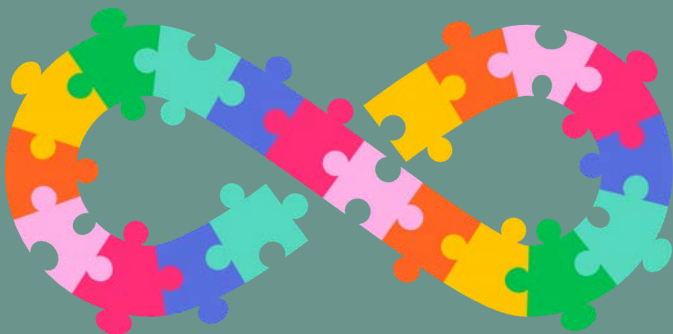

This is being submitted to Bexley as part of their exhibition too.

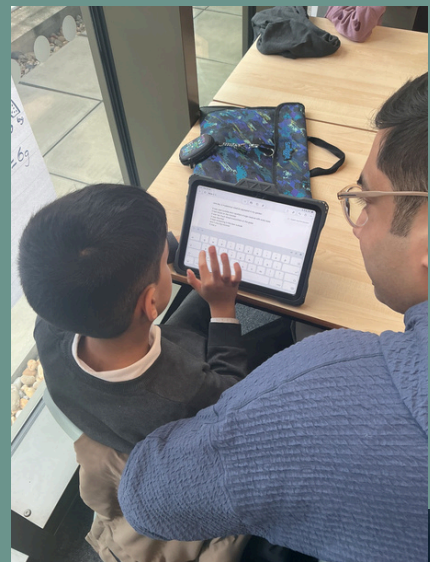
