## **Parent Survey Feedback**

#### Thank you once again - we had 29 responses in total and will report back on findings each week. The school lets me know how my child is doing

13 of you responded with 'strongly agree' and 15 responded with 'agree' - fantastic! We hold parents evening opportunities in Autumn and Spring and then in the Summer there will be the opportunity for you to discuss your child's end of year report. Each week we share learning in this newsletter and we have been delighted with the use of Showbie as a tool to showcase all of your children's learning on a daily basis.

#### There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school

14 responded 'strongly agree' and 10 responded 'agree'. 5 responses indicated that some of you 'don't know' - in Reception we follow the EYFS Framework which is split across all areas of learning: Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Arts & Design, Personal Social & Emotional Development, Communication & Language and finally Physical Development. As we prepare for your child to transition to Year 1, we are preparing the LWP curriculum to be in line with the National Curriculum. We will follow the full range of subjects expected at primary. We are continuously adding to the school website with more information about these subjects.

#### My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school

16 of you 'strongly agree' and 11 'agree'. 1 response was 'disagree' and 1 was 'don't know'. We are proud of the activities that are available to the children at LWP with an after school club option every night of the week. At the start of term we also introduced lunchtime clubs every day for children to access. This is a fantastic provision to be in place for Reception children. If you are unsure of the options, please do check our website for more information.

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
