Ms Chen is another Cover Teacher who will support the school and ensure consistency for our children.



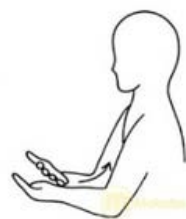
In addition, Mrs Watkin, is a new SEND TA who will be working across Year 1 for the rest of the academic year.

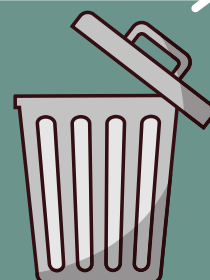

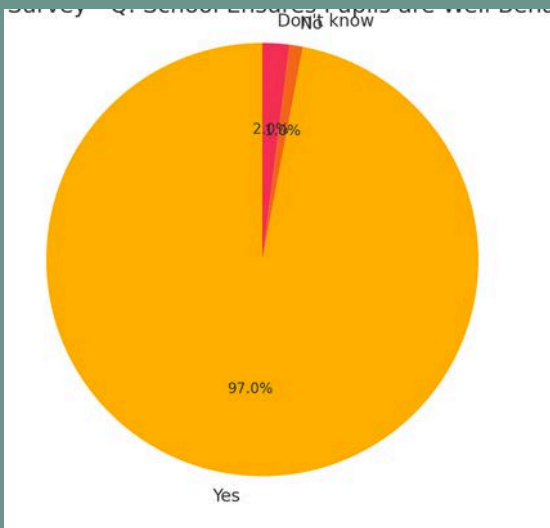

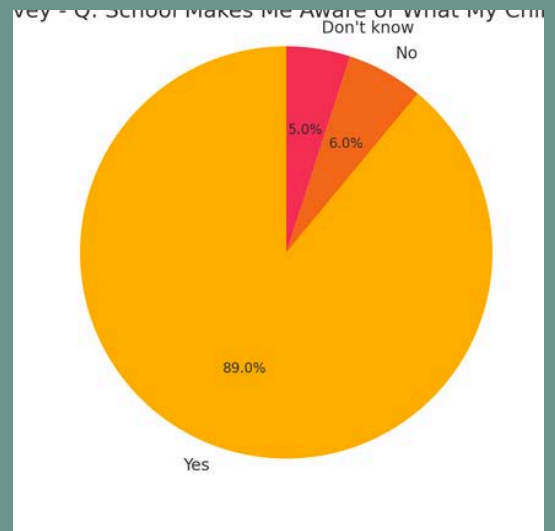

The school makes sure it's pupils are well behaved

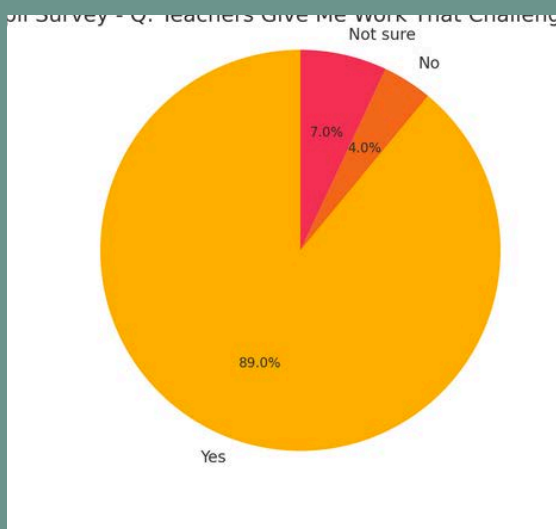


The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

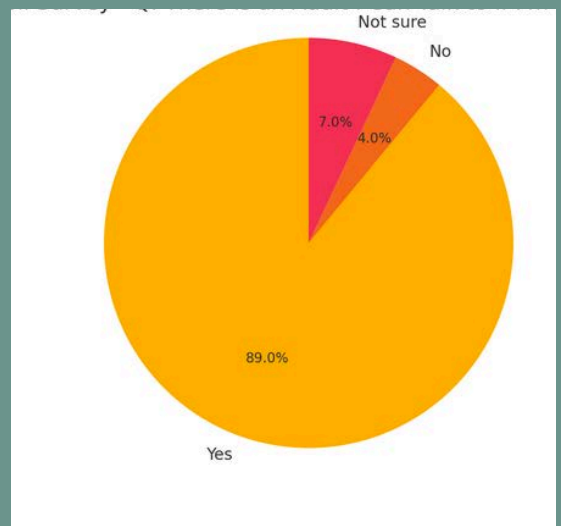

There is an adult at school I can talk to if something is worrying me

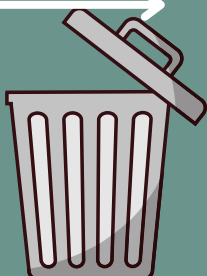
