In addition. Mrs Watkin, is a new SEND TA who will be working across Year 1 for the rest of the academic year.



Magma Maths is a great app for the children to use in school that allows them to deepen their independent application of knowledge as well as work with manipulatives at the same time.



There are bins located around the school and we kindly request all members of the community use the bins to dispose of their chewing gum.






