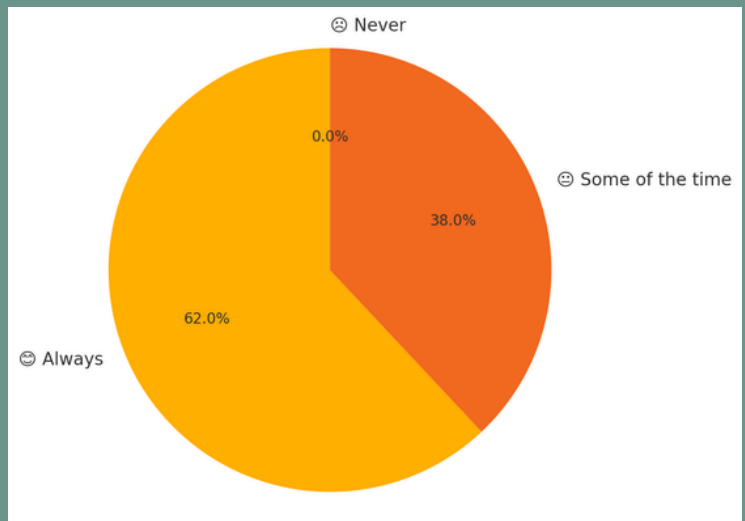
PUPIL SURVEY

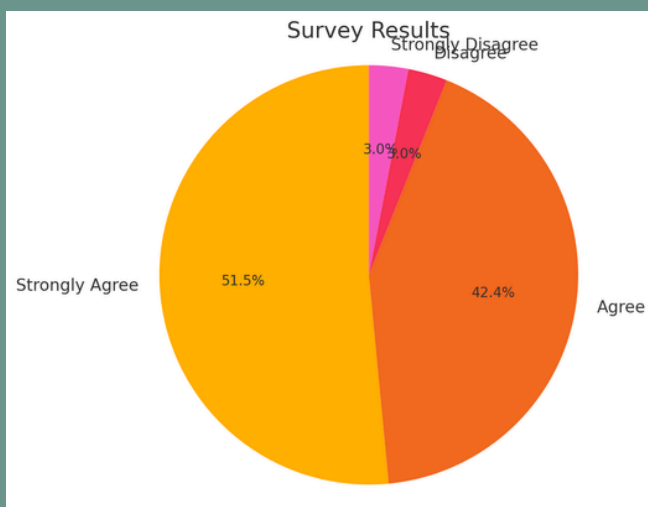

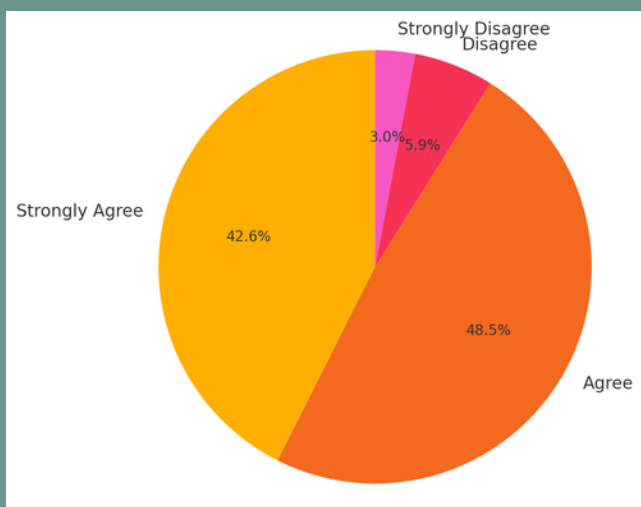
PARENT SURVEY
