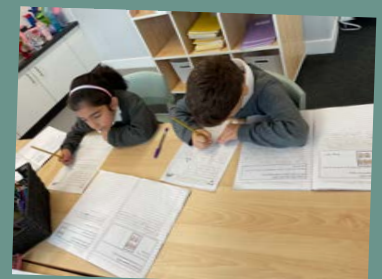
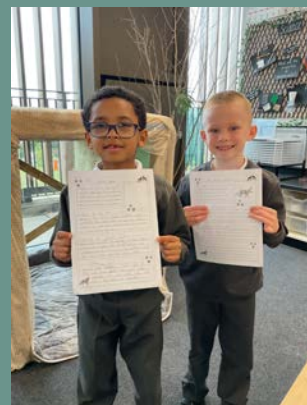
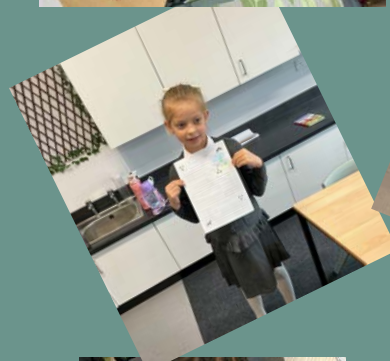
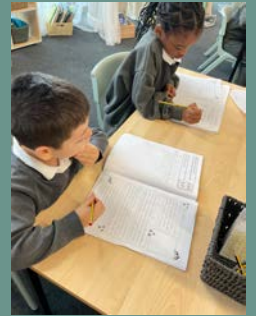
"Clever Never Goes" sessions delivered to our Year 1 & Year 2 by PC Ryan

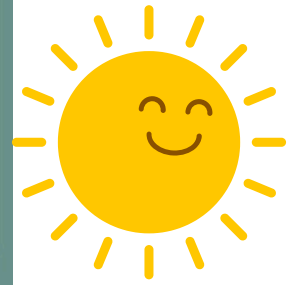
