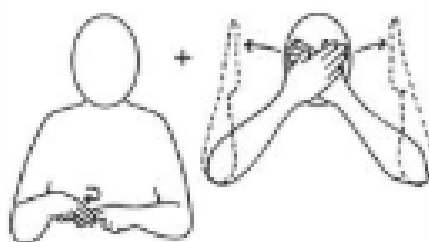

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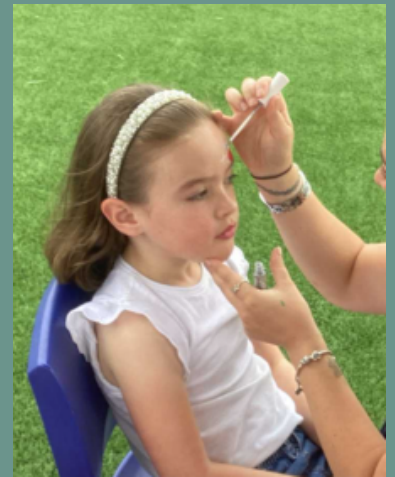

Why Do These Age Limits Matter?

- ✓ Protects children from inappropriate content
- ✓ Reduces exposure to online strangers and cyberbullying
- ✓ Limits data collection from underage users
- ✓ Supports emotional development without added social pressure
