Attendance

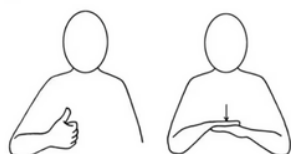

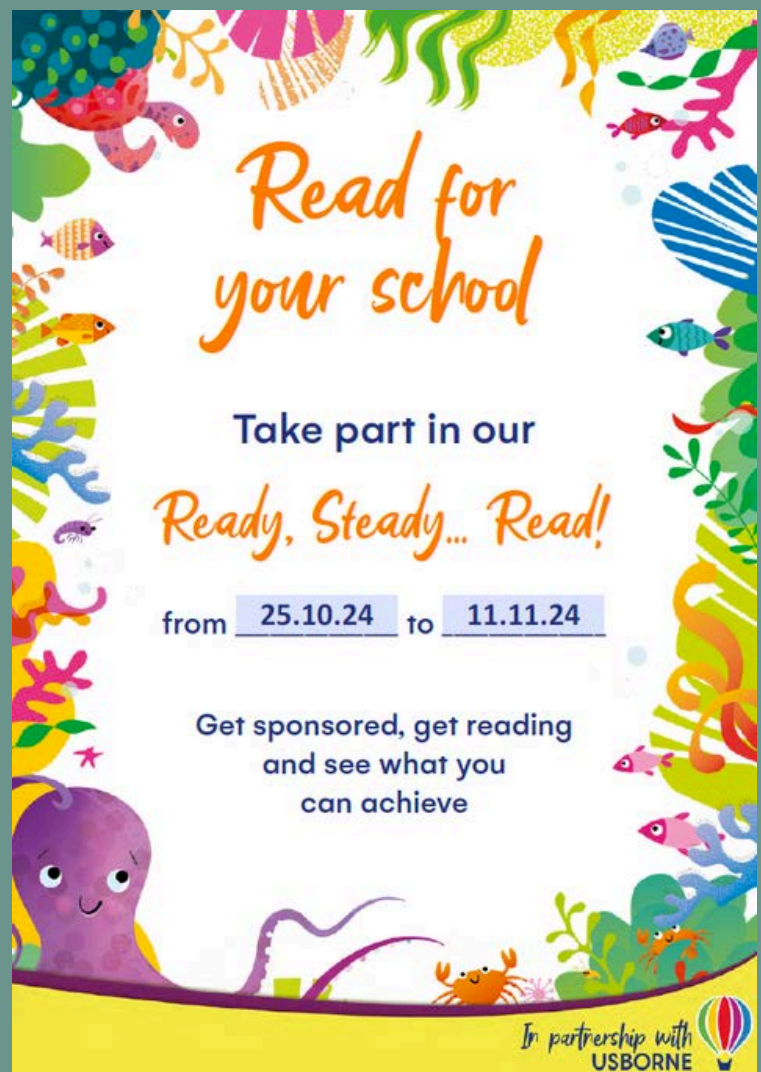
We hope that the children's sponsored reading is going well.

The children enjoyed exploring the story of Rama and Sita, making Diwali cards, Rangoli patterns and edible fireworks!



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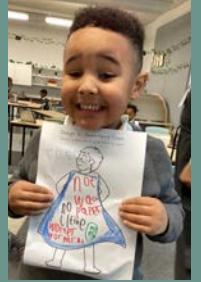

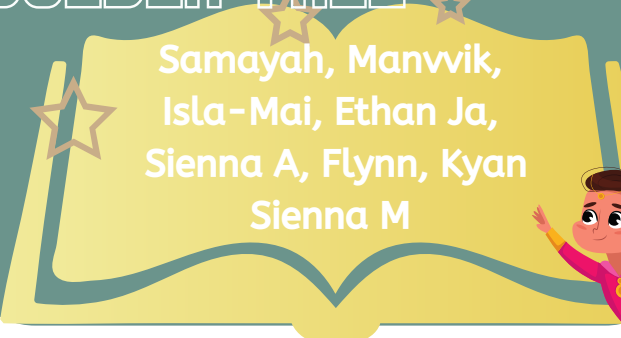
