We have now completed the mini marathon challenge and children in Year 1 have received their certificates today - hand delivered by Mrs Cunningham who also joined in all of the fun!

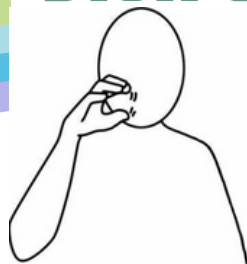
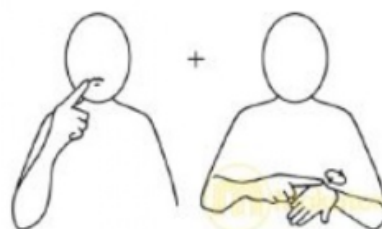

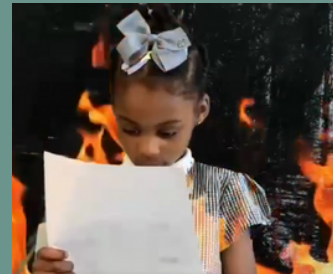
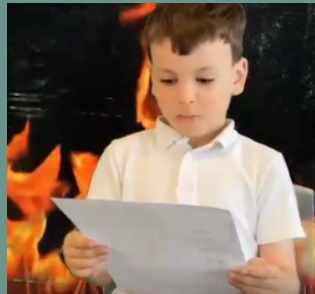
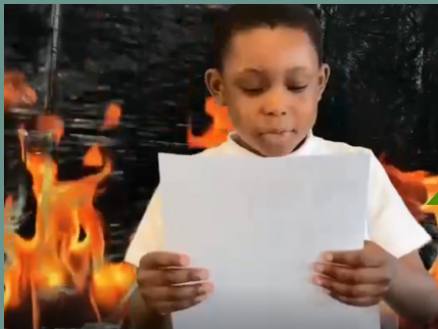
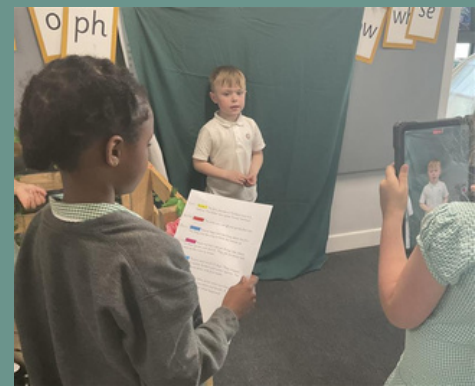




# WE LOVE LEARNING Y1
