EYFS CURRICULUM NEWS



In EYFS, there are seven areas of learning which are:
The 'prime areas':

- Communication and language
 - Physical development
- Personal, social and emotional development

The 'specific areas':

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design

Mathematics

Children have been learning to match and sort objects using a variety of categories.



Physical Development

PE lessons this term are focused on children following simple instructions and moving to a safe space as well as understanding what a safe space is.

Literacy

We have begun teaching phase 2 phonics. The children have been learning the letter name and sound for s a t p as well as how to form these letters correctly. In class we are encouraging children to find objects starting with one of these sounds - s for sun, a for apple, t for tap, p for pig
