



Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Spring 1

How did people travel long ago?



Big Bang Day	Tuesday 7 th January - The children will be dressing in the colour blue; we will be using markup to create our own bus driver uniforms. We will make different types of artwork related to modes of transport and using a green screen and iMovie to create fun transport films.
English	This term, children will be exploring the Naughty Bus by Jan and Jerry Oke. The children will write their own journey tale about a different mode of transport focusing on exclamation marks and recapping on prior learning about adjectives.
Maths	The children will be extending their knowledge of numbers up to 20 using a variety of manipulatives to support their learning and understanding of place value.
Humanities	Our focus is History this term. The children will be learning all about the different types of transport and how they have changed over time. They will also be looking at chronology and be introduced to a timeline where they will be adding transport from then and now.
Art/D&T	Our focus is DT this term. They will be learning about slides and levers. The children will be designing and creating their own moving toy based on the Naughty Bus story.
Music	The children will be learning about different music from around the world and different historical periods. They will develop their listening skills and understand that music tells a story.
Computing	The children will focus on Artificial Intelligence. This will introduce the children to what AI is, how it works, and where it appears in everyday life, including its benefits and challenges. Pupils then create, test, and improve simple AI models using visual programming tools to see how data affects an AI system's performance.
Religious Education	Our key question is "What makes some places sacred?". They will be able to recognise that there are special places where people go to worship and talk about what people do there. They will be able to identify at least three objects used in worship in two religions.
Physical Education	The children will be developing their agility, coordination and balance skills. They will understand why we need these skills in sports to be successful.
Personal Development	In Health & Relationships this term, the children will be learning about who in our community looks after us.
