<p>Would you like to eat the same foods?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore traditional foods (tacos, beans, corn) • Write instructions for making a simple dish • Taste or role-play a Mexican meal 	<p>What is special about Mexican celebrations?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn about Day of the Dead (age-appropriate) • Create masks or decorations • Compare with UK celebrations 	<p>How do people express themselves?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to traditional music • Create colourful patterns inspired by Mexican art • Explore rhythm using instruments
