Phonics Workshop for Parents and Carers

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we will be running a workshop for parents and carers on Tuesday 10th October, where we will share details with you about our chosen phonics program and how you can support your child/ren with their phonics learning at home.

Phonics is a way of teaching children to read and write by making connections between the sounds of our spoken words and the letters that are used to write them down. This is the approach recommended by the government and at Lime Wood Primary School, we follow the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds systematic synthetic phonics programme.

We recognise that parents/carers play a vital role in their children's learning and really value your support. Therefore, at the session, we will share with you our approach to teaching, some useful resources for you to use at home and techniques for supporting your child with reading at home. At the session, parents and carers will be welcome to ask any questions they might have with regards to phonics and early reading. This half hour workshop will begin at 9am.
